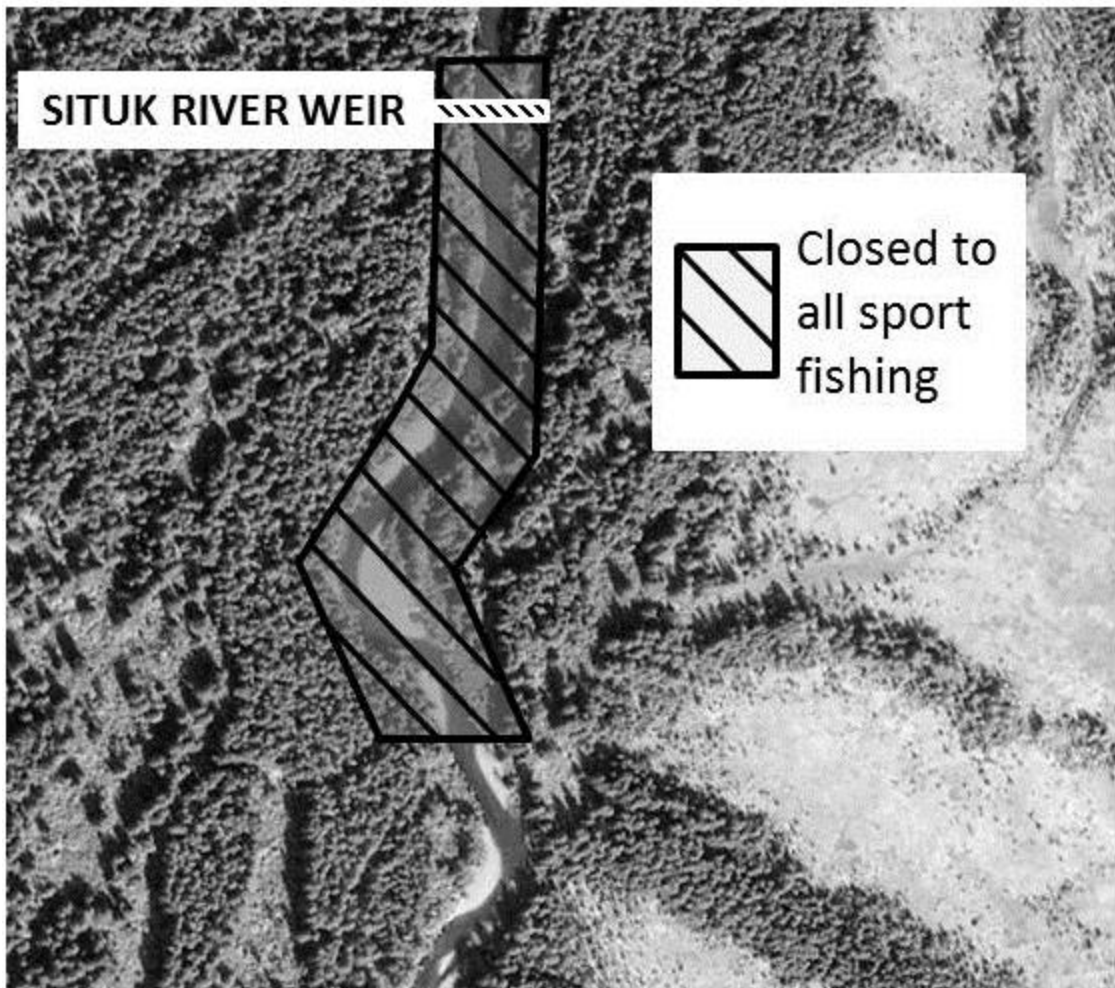


# Lower Situk River Closure Area

From July 10 to August 15 the Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G) has closed sport fishing between regulatory markers located approximately 300 feet upstream of the Situk River weir to markers located approximately 2,100 feet downstream of the weir. This portion of the river encompasses the entire “Rodeo Hole”.



This closure protects king salmon from incidental hooking and catch-and-release angling while they seek passage through the ADF&G weir.
